## Consider as you discuss:

- What is the probable impact if **no one speaks up** in this situation?
- What could be the **positive outcomes if someone does intervene** and speak up?
- What could you do to <u>ADDRESS\*</u> the situation?
  - A = Acknowledge (that something occurred)
  - **D** = Dialogue (in the moment or afterwards)
  - **D** = "Document" (tell someone; use the Bias Reporting System)
  - **R** = Redirect (the conversation)
  - **E** = Educate (the person)
  - **S** = Stop (the exclusionary behavior)
  - **S** = Support (the people impacted)
